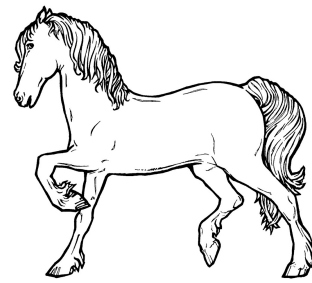



**HARWICH TOWN BATHSIDE BITTER  
4.2%abv**

American style pale ale with oodles of Cascade hops. Good bitterness levels followed by sweet hop taste and then the Cascade really kicks in for a real citrus aroma.

Location: Harwich, Essex



**NETHERGATE AUGUSTINIAN 4.5%abv**

A wonderfully smooth drinking premium beer, with a hint of crystal malt. The late addition of Styrian Goldings in the boil lends the beer a continental flavour.

Location: Stour Valley, Pentlow, Essex



**CROUCH VALE BLACKWATER MILD  
3.7%abv**

Smooth and malty dark mild for drinking in quantity! Fruity and full.

Location: South Woodham Ferrers, nr. Chelmsford



**OSSETT BIG RED 4.0%abv**

A full-bodied ruby red ale with an initial maltiness leading to citrus / spicy bitterness at the end.

Location: Ossett, West Yorkshire



**CLIFF QUAY BITTER 3.4%abv**

Classic bitter full flavoured light amber coloured rich marmalade flavours and balance of bitter and sweet flavours

Location: Ipswich Suffolk



**LODDON HULLABALOO 4.2%abv**

A copper coloured Best Bitter with a rich, nutty malt balanced by the dry herby flavour of English Fuggle hops. Guaranteed to cause a stir!

Location: Dunsden, Oxfordshire



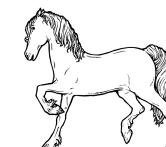
**BREWSTERS DECADENCE 4.4%abv**

A golden ale with a hint of malt sweetness from caramalt. Passionfruit and grapefruit aromas on the nose. First taste gives a complex zesty hop palate leading on to a fresh herby finish.

**NETHERGATE UMBEL MAGNA 5.0%abv**

Special Porter: the addition of coriander to the Old Growler wort completes the original 1750's recipe. Step back in time and taste the spiciness of this deep ruby beer.

GBBF winner: Gold Speciality Beer 09

Location: Stour Valley, Pentlow, Essex



**DARK STAR OLD CHESTNUT 4.0%abv**

A dark mellow beer with a hint of burnt smoky sweet flavour and restrained bitterness from the Golding hops. Brewed with a mixed grist including chocolate malted barley

Location: Haywards Heath, Sussex



**OSSETT REAL ALE REVOLUTION IPA  
4.5%abv**

Pale & bitter with pine & citrus aromas. Slight spice to the pallet with an underlying sweetness.

Location: Ossett, West Yorkshire



**MAULDONS BLACK ADDER 5.3%abv**

A dark bitter stout. Roast and nut aromas with a fruity balance of hops and dark malt providing an excellent lingering finish.

Location: Sudbury, Suffolk



**ROOSTERS HEDGEHOG 3.7%abv**

Some toffee notes, soft bitterness and delicate citrus floral aromas.

Location: Knaresborough

Westons Original Perry 4.5%abv**

Light and fruity with a well balanced sweetness. A perfect drink for all occasions



**THATCHERS Somerset Cider 6.0%abv**
