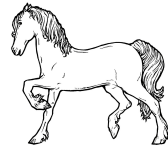


**THE WHITE HORSE,

NETHERGATE – SUFFOLK COUNTY 4.0%abv

A chestnut best bitter, biscuity malt dominates the warm well rounded roasted background, with a punching bitterness.
Location: Stour Valley



WADWORTH – HORIZON 4.0%abv

Easy drinking. Brewed with 100% Pale Ale Malt, golden in colour with a zesty, citrus & hop aroma, with a crisp finish
Location: Devizes



ST.AUSTELL – CORNISH BEST 3.5%abv

Crafted from British hops, Maris Otter barley and Cornish spring water, Cornish Best is an easy-drinking, traditional, well balanced bitter with wide appeal.
Location: Cornwall



SALOPIAN – DARWIN'S ORIGIN 4.3%abv

Specially brewed in 2009 to celebrate the bicentennial of Charles Darwin's birth. Copper coloured beer that evolves with a pronounced hop character which leads to a refined malt finish.
Location: Hadnall, Shropshire*Silver Medal Bitter GBBF 2016



OLD CANNON – BLONDE BOMBSHELL 4.2%abv

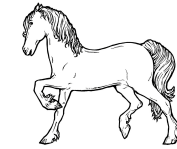
This golden bitter has excellent body allied to a clean and refreshing character. First gold hops and East Anglian malt combine to give a smooth, well-balanced flavour.

THE DOVE – UNDERWOOD MILD 3.2%abv

Named after Ipswich's loyal towns man Peter. This dark traditional thirst quenching mild. Packed with flavour and aroma, with freshness and spice

COLCHESTER – BRAZILIAN 4.6%abv

Brewed as a traditional Porter with fuggles and goldings hops but with the addition of roasted coffee beans and vanilla extract.
Location: Colchester



MIGHTY OAK – TOE WRESTLER 3.6%abv

The International Toe Wrestling Championships take place during August. This golden hoppy summer ale celebrates this momentous event!
Location: Maldon, Essex



THE DOVE – BORN IN THE USA 5.2%abv

Brewed July 4th 2016 (American Independence Day) to celebrate 5 years of brewing at the brewery. An American pale Ale with three American hops, Willamette, Galena & Cascade.
Location: Ipswich



CLIFF QUAY – DOWN THE HATCH 4.1%abv

An amber coloured bitter with fresh citrus aromas that develop into a balanced fruity and refreshing dry bitter finish.
Location: Debenham, Suffolk



GREEN JACK – GONE FISHING 5.5%abv

Very traditional in style, even though it is brewed with American hops. A deep amber in coloured ale, it is fruity and malty - it goes down far too easily for a beer of this strength.
Location: Lowestoft, Suffolk



MAULDONS – ORANGE ADDER 3.6%abv

A refreshing light golden beer that has a distinctive citrus finish.
Location: Sudbury, Suffolk
